Hiding

What do we do with guilt

Gen. 3:7a Then the eyes of both were opened, and they knew that they were naked.

eyes were opened

Gen 1:28 (multiply) gen 2:17 (surely die) Gen 3:1-6 (died) Gen 3:20 (mother of all living)

We hide from it with legalism

Gen 3:7b And they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves loincloths.

legalism does not hide guilt

Matt 23:25-28 (it reveals hypocrisy) Col 2:20-23 (it reveals your true self) Isaiah 64:6 (it reveals your filthiness)

it hides grace

Gen. 3:21 (His provision - 1st death) Rom 3:23-25 (hiding from this propitiation) Rom 5:12-21 (hiding from this eternal life) Phil 3:8-9 (hiding from this covering)

We hide from it with loneliness

Gen. 3:8 ¶ And they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool (wind) of the day, and **the man and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD** God among the trees of the garden.

loneliness does not hide guilt

Rev 6:16 vs 22:4 (it reveals your separation) **it hides love** Jn 3:16-21 (love or loneliness/ light or dark) Rom 5:6-8 (hiding from this love)

We hide from it with lies

Gen. 3:9 But the LORD God called to the man and said to him, "Where are you?" (*will you confess*) Gen. 3:10 And he said, "I heard the sound of you in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked, and I hid myself."

Gen. 3:11 He said, "Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten of the tree of which I commanded (*the issue was the Word not the tree*) you not to eat?" (*confess?*)

Gen. 3:12 The man said, "**The woman whom you gave to be with me**, she gave me fruit of the tree, and I ate." Gen. 3:13 Then the LORD God said to the woman, "What is this that you have done?" (confess?) The woman said, "**The serpent deceived me, and I ate.**"

lies do not hide guilt

Jn 9:35-41 (you say you see) they hide truth Luke 5:29-32 (hiding from this truth) 1 Jn 1:5-10 (confess) Ik 15:11-24 (come home)Genesis 1:28

Hiding

Intro:

your life is an observable, repeatable, historically reliable and personally available record of the fact that Man is not good- video

Problem:

all have sinned rom 3:10-12 leads us right into Gen 3:7...

Main Idea:

What do we do with guilt we hide from it with legalism we hide from it with loneliness we hide from it with lies

Implication:

your legalism is hiding you from grace not guilt your loneliness is hiding you from love not guilt your lies are hiding you from truth not guilt

Application:

are you hiding from grace? are you hiding from love? are you hiding from truth?

confess - 1 Jn 1:5-10 its time to come home - lk 15:11-24
