Forensic Boasting

Intro video:

Our love is largely hype (Peter Gabriel "in your eyes" written in 1986 - divorced in 1987)

The definitive peace, the dependable hope and the devoted love of God is not hype - it is based on the finished work of Christ (Video - > this love)

Problem:

Matt 26:30-35 (justified not by the amount of our faith but by the object of our faith- Matt 14:28-33 -Peter looked to the wrong object - here he did it again -our love is hype his is not)

Main Idea:

Forensic justification means... forensic peace forensic hope forensic love

Implication:

Forensic boasting

Rom 3:27; 4:1-2... (where then is boasting)
Rom 5:2-3, 11 (rejoice (kaochaomai) = boast)
1 Cor 1:26-31 (Your works are hype - his are not - boast in Him)
True peace is based on His work (5:1)
Dependable hope is based on His grace (5:2, 5)
Reliable love is based on His love (5:11)

Application:

Jn 14:27 (the peace of God can only come from forensic peace with God - subjective peace, hope and love come from their objective counterpart)

Jn 16:33 (In this world you will have tribulation but take heart)

Forensic Boasting

Text:

Forensic justification means

Rom. 5:1a Therefore, since we have been justified by faith,

Rom 4:23-25 (*Therefore by faith...*)

Rom 3:21-26 (we have forensic justification...so what?)

The adjective forensic comes from the Latin word forensis, meaning "in open court" or "public." Forensic justification means legal, judicial, or objective justification

Forensic peace

Rom 5:1b we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Psalm 7:11 (God is mad because He is good)

Eph 5:6 (He is mad at our deeds)

Rom 8:7 (we were enemies)

Rom 5:9-11 (Not peace of God but peace with God- saved by God from God)

Col 1:21-22 (not a fake fickle peace based on mood - but forensic peace)

2 Cor 5:16-21 (subjective peace based on our objective peace)

Eph 2:13-19 (He himself is our objective forensic peace)

Forensic hope

Rom. 5:2 Through him we have also obtained (perfect) access (prosagoge- ushered into presence of royalty/safe harbor) by faith into this grace in which we stand (perfect), and we rejoice (boast) in hope of the glory of God.

Rom. 5:3 Not only that, but **we rejoice (boast) in our sufferings**, **knowing (perfect)** that suffering produces endurance,

Rom. 5:4 and endurance produces character, and character produces hope,

Rom. 5:5a and hope does not put us to shame,

Heb 4:14-16 (with confidence draw near based on what? Not a wish or desire...)

Heb 6:13-20 (Looking forward based on looking backward)

Heb 10:11-23 (the forensic work upon the cross once for all)

James 1:2-8 (subjective hope - knowing etc- is based on objective forensic hope)

1 Pet 1:3-9 (subjective hope based on our objective, living, forensic hope)

Forensic love

Rom 5:5b because **God's love has been poured (perfect)** into our hearts **through the Holy Spirit** who has been given to us.

Rom. 5:6 ¶ For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly.

Rom. 5:7 For one will scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—

Rom. 5:8 but God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Rom. 5:9 **Since**, therefore, we have now been justified by his blood, **much more shall we be saved by him from the wrath of God**.

Rom. 5:10 For if (since) while we were enemies we were **reconciled** to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are **reconciled**, shall we be **saved by his life**.

Rom. 5:11 More than that, we also **rejoice (boast) in God through our Lord Jesus Christ**, **through whom** we have now **received reconciliation**.

1 Jn 4:16-19 - Our love is based on His - more than who loved first...

1 Jn 3:16 - subjective love is based in His objective forensic love (Jn 3:16)
