Problem:

the sin of compromise

the church is often found confronting the culture while conforming to - 1 Jn 2:15-17; the fear is that we will profess to know God but deny Him by our works - titus 1:16

Main Idea:

Our lesson from Pergamum: a church that is courageous in the culture but compromising within has nonetheless become an enemy of Him The danger is not culture but compromise

Implication:

we are not at war with culture but with sin - 1 Pet 2:11-12

Application:

fighting sin is not about loss but about gain - heb 12:1-2

Text:

Our lesson from Pergamum:

Rev. 2:12 \P "And to the angel of the church in **Pergamum** write: 'The words of him who has the **sharp two-edged sword**.

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pergamum - parchment (pergamena) - great library - not economically impressive but culturally impressive -capitol of asia for 400 yrs -their proconsul had "the right of the sword" they could put any person to death at their word alone sword - Heb 4:12; Eph 6:17; Rev 19:15
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A church that is courageous in the culture

Rev. 2:13 ¶ "'I know where you dwell, where Satan's throne is. Yet **you hold fast my name**, and **you did not deny my faith** even in the days of Antipas my faithful witness (martyr), who was killed among you, where Satan dwells.

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satan throne - it was the center of Caesar worship - eph 2:1-3
it was the place where people were required on pain of death to take the name of Lord and give it
to Caesar instead of to Christ
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But compromising within

Rev. 2:14 But I have a few things against you: you have some there who hold **the teaching of Balaam**, who taught Balak to put a stumbling block before the sons of Israel, so that they might eat food sacrificed to idols and practice sexual immorality.

Rev. 2:15 So also you have some who hold the teaching of the Nicolaitans.

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Balaam - Num 24:10-25:9; 31:13-16; Jude 10-13; 2 Pet 2:12-15; compromise within - 1 Cor 5; 2 Cor 6:14-17 - affects whole church nicolations -contrast ephesus - Rev 2:2, 6
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has nonetheless become an enemy of Him

Rev. 2:16 Therefore repent. If not, I will come to you soon (suddenly) and war <u>against them</u> with the sword of my mouth.

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war against them - James 4:4; Jn 15:18-20; 2 tim 3:12-13;
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The danger is not culture but compromise

Rev. 2:17 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To the one who **conquers** I will give some of the **hidden manna**, and I will give him a **white stone**, with **a new name** written on the stone **that no one knows except the one who receives it.**'

implication: conquers - we are not at war with culture we are at war with sin - 1 Pet 2:11-12 be killing sin or sin be killing you overcome - Jn 16:33 -> 1 in 5:4-5 - not our effort but His- through the cross

Application: i will give - not about loss but gain - Heb 12:1-2 (lay aside); phil 3:7-11 (to gain)
- gaining Him as our security- nothing else (food sacrificed to idols)
- manna - jn 6:25-35; 48-51 - gaining Him as our significance - nothing else
- white stone with new name - (acquittal blackballed comes from this)
- Matt 16:13-18 simon or Peter (abram/abraham, jacob/Israel, Saul/Paul)

- Judges 6:11-16 gideon - but i will be with you
