John 14:15 ¶ "If you love me, you will keep my commandments.

John 14:16 And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever,

John 14:17 even **the Spirit of truth**, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for **he <u>dwells</u> with you and will be in you.**

John 14:18 ¶ "I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you. (double meaning)

John 14:19 Yet a little while and the world will see me no more, but you will see me. Because I live, you also will live.

John 14:20 In that day you will know that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you.

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to be with forever - why is this so significant
- alienation from God and one another- Gen 3:8-12 (our parents); Eph 2:11-16 (us)

dwells - union with one another union with God -1 Cor 6:19-20 (compare OT temple)
at the moment of salvation- 1 Cor 12:12-13; Eph 1:13-14 united to God and one another...
- Eph 1:22-23 (body)-do not dismember the body
- Eph 2:19-22 (building) -do not destroy the building
- Eph 5:25-32 (bride) - do not stain the bride
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His commandments - John 13:34-35

looks like obedience

John 14:21 Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves me. And he who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and manifest myself to him."

John 14:22 Judas (not Iscariot) said to him, "Lord, how is it that you will manifest yourself to us, and not to the world?"

John 14:23 Jesus answered him, "If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him.

John 14:24 Whoever does not love me does not keep my words. And the word that you hear is not mine but the Father's who sent me.

John 14:25 ¶ "These things I have spoken to you while I am still with you.

John 14:26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance **all that I have said to you**.

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love linked with commandments - why is this so significant
- autonomy, freedom through cosmic treason
- john Paul sartre - Gen 3:1-5 (our parents) -disobedience as self deification - Phil 3:17-19 (us)
all that i said - the Word made more sure - 2 pet 1:16-2:3 and obedience
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and feels like peace

John 14:27 Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid.

John 14:28 You heard me say to you, 'I am going away, and I will come to you.' **If you loved me**, you would have rejoiced, because I am going to the Father, for the Father is greater than I.

John 14:29 And now I have told you before it takes place, so that when it does take place you may believe.

John 14:30 I will no longer talk much with you, for the ruler of this world is coming. He has no claim on me,

John 14:31 but I do as the Father has commanded me, so that the world may know that I love the Father. Rise, let us go from here.

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hearts troubled - jn 14:1 why is this so significant
-> autonomy...leads to anxiety - Gen 3:6-7 (our parents); col 2:8, 16-23 - fig leaves (us)

peace IN Him - Rom 5:1 (peace through Him)
