True faith is a gift

1John 5:1a Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ has been born of God (perfect),

(1a) regeneration precedes faith - Jn 1:9-13; 11:38-44; eph 2:1-10; James 1:18; 1 Pet 1:3; Remember it - Romans 8:28-39

True faith is a lifestyle

1 John 5b and everyone who loves the Father loves whoever has been born of him (perfect).

1John 5:2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and obey his commandments.

1John 5:3 For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments (circles back to 5b). And <u>his commandments are not burdensome</u>.

(2) His commandments - 1 Jn 2:3-11
love one another - 1 Jn 4:7-21 -> faith and love inseparable (15-16)
(3) not burdensome - matt 11:28-30
if your not born of Him an impossible book with impossible commands - 1 Cor 2:12-16
live it - 1 Jn 3:16-18 - deed and truth
```

True faith is a weapon

1John 5:4 For everyone who has been born of God (perfect) overcomes (present) the world. And this is the <u>victory</u> that <u>has overcome (aorist-overcame)</u> the world—our faith (only noun form of believe (pistis) in all of John).

1John 5:5 Who is it that overcomes the world except the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

(4a) overcomes - 1 Jn 2:13-17 - a continuous battle
(4b) overcame - Jn 16:32-33 - an assured victory - our possession of faith
crucified with Christ - Gal 2:20
risen with Christ - Rom 6:3-5
glorified with Christ - Col 3:1-4
seated with Christ - Eph 2:5-7
wield it - eph 6:16
```
